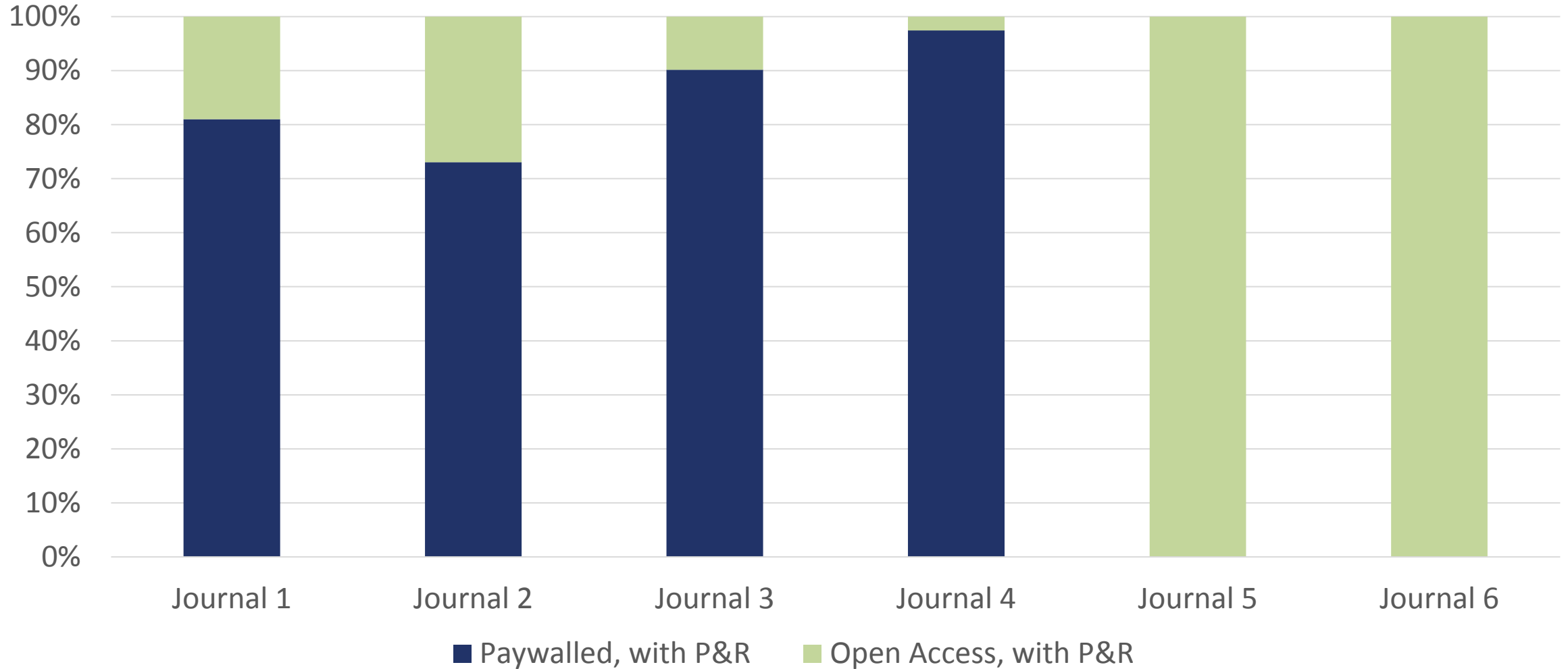


Open Access distribution

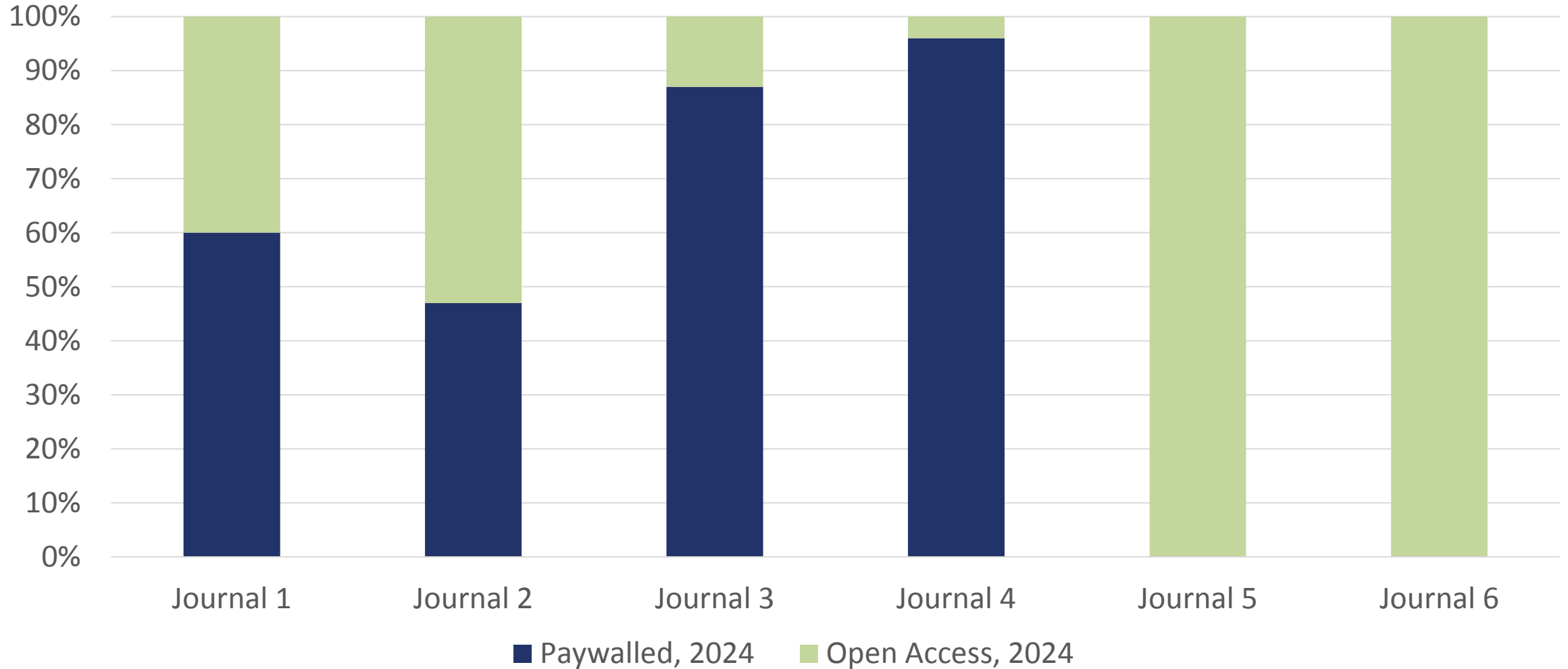


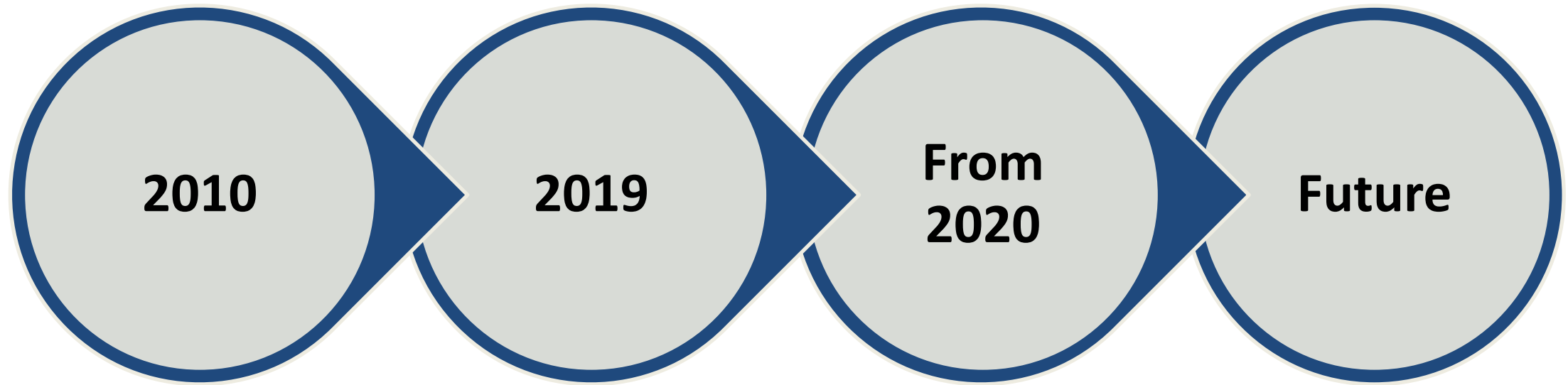


Open Access distribution with P&R institutions



Open Access distribution in 2024 with P&R



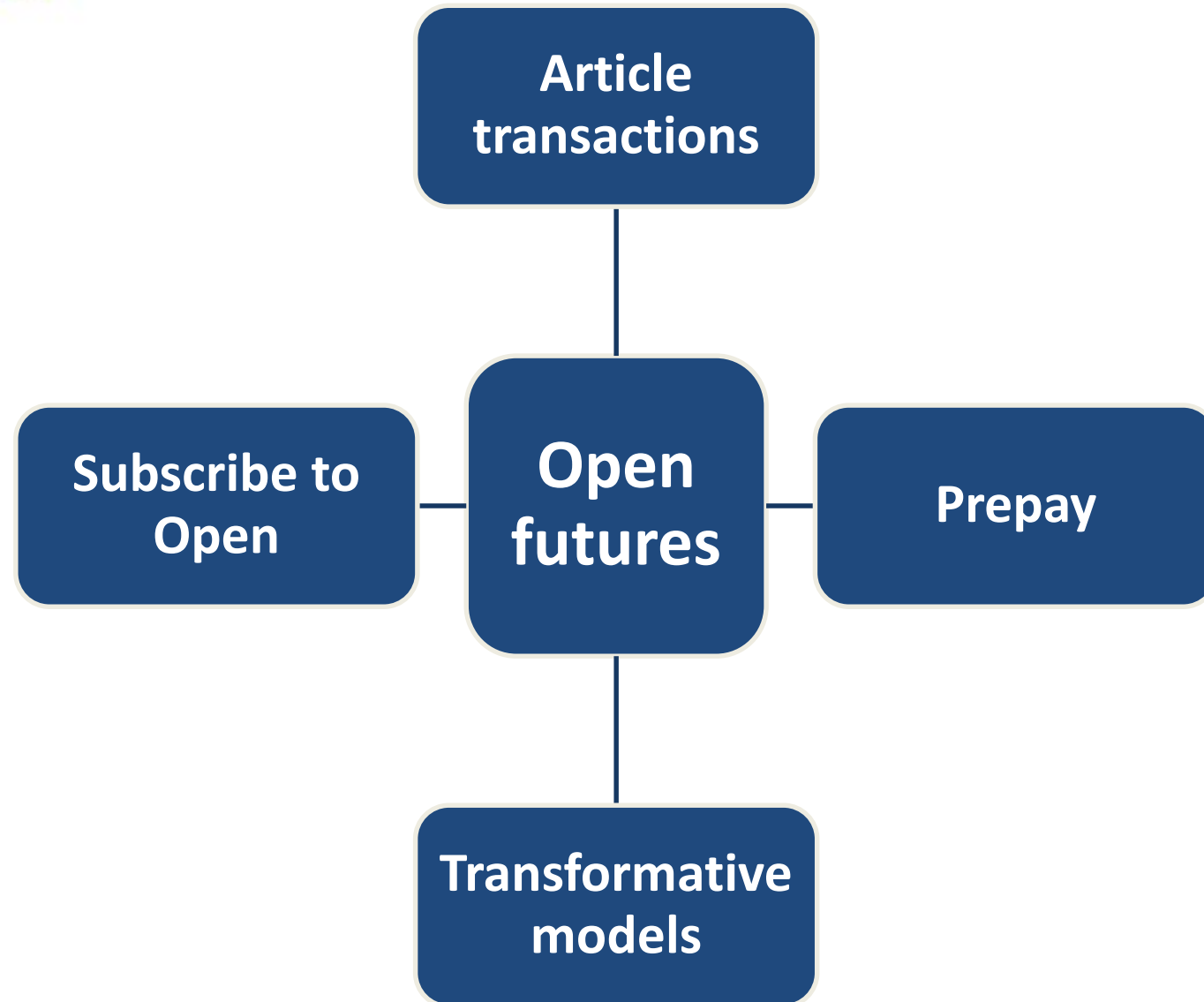
